

When to Use

The Flash Photo Gallery page type allows you to display images in an album or slide-show format. When you create the gallery, you indicate which Digital Assets Library folders contain the images to display on the page. When the page is published, all image files in the selected folders are displayed as your photo gallery or slide show.

This page type differs from the Photo Gallery page type in that you are provided with more display options, including the ability to size the presentation area of your gallery, select background colors, and size the thumbnails and chose how many thumbnails are visible.

If you want to create a page for non-image files, use the Digital Asset Gallery page type.

Examples of How to Use

- ▶ Display photos from community events.
- ▶ Post progress photos of ongoing engineering projects.
- ▶ Provide photo albums showcasing tourist locations.

Flash Photo Gallery Page Sections & Fields

<i>Page Section</i>	<i>Field Name/Item</i>	<i>Description of usage</i>
Gallery Properties	Allow Full Screen Mode	Select the Full screen mode option to provide an option for gallery visitors to open a full screen version of the gallery. If enabled, a small "full screen" button will appear at the corner of your gallery.
	Display	<p>Names Select the Names option to display the name from the Name field of the Digital Assets. The name will display below the full size image. Changing an asset name must be done from the Digital Asset Detail screen.</p> <p>Descriptions Select the Descriptions option to display the text from the Description field of the Digital Assets. Adding or editing of existing description text must be done from the Digital Asset Detail screen.</p> <p>Thumbnails Select the Thumbnails option to show a row of thumbnails above or below the full size image area.</p>
	Slide Show	<p>Enable Select this option to provide an automated slide show for your site visitors.</p>
		<p>Show Controls Select this option to provide controls to stop and start, or fast forward and rewind the side show. Choose to display the controls at the top or</p>

		Time between frames Set the time each image will automatically display during the slide show.
	Image Title Font	Choose the font, size, style and color for the image title font.
	Image Title Alignment	Choose the alignment of the image title. Choose from left, right and center.
	Image Title Height	Enter the number of pixels of vertical space the title should occupy. You may need to adjust this setting to make sure you have selected a value large enough to display the full text.
	Image Description Font	Choose the font, size, style and color for the image description font.
	Image Description Alignment	Choose the alignment of the image description. Choose from left, right and center.
	Image Description Height	Enter the number of pixels of vertical space the description should occupy. You may need to adjust this setting to make sure you have selected a value large enough to display the full text.
	Player Width	Enter a pixel width for the Flash player, this allows you to customize the size of the player within the page template.
	Player Height	Enter a pixel height for the Flash player, this allows you to customize the size of the player within the page template.
	Player Background Color	Use the color picker to set a background color for the flash player. This will encompass the full size image, name, description and thumbnail areas as set by the player width and height set above.
	Thumbnail Width	Enter a pixel width for each thumbnail. This will set the width for landscape oriented images.
	Thumbnail Height	Enter a pixel height for each thumbnail. This will set the height for vertical oriented images.
	Thumbnail Count	Enter the number of thumbnails to display within the player without scrolling. The default setting is 4. If you set the number of thumbnails to be larger than the content width of your page, your gallery will not

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		display correctly.
	Thumbnail Background Colour	Use the color picker to set a background color for the thumbnail display area.
	Thumbnail Selected Background Color	Use the color picker to set a background color of the selected thumbnail. This colour will appear around the thumbnail image when it has been selected for viewing.
	Thumbnail Hover Background Color	Use the color picker to set a background color a thumbnail as the mouse is moved over it. This colour will appear around the thumbnail image when a gallery visitor hovers over each thumbnail prior to selecting one for viewing.
	Select Folders to Include in the Gallery	Select the folder(s) that contain the images to include in the gallery. Each time a new image is added to the selected asset folder(s), the image will automatically be added to the photo gallery.
Introduction	n/a	The text entered here appears at the top of the gallery page, above the images.
Conclusion	n/a	Text entered here appears at the bottom of the gallery page, below the images.

Flash Photo Gallery Page Tips!

- ▶ Be sure to size all of the digital assets to the correct display size before making them available for use on your site.
- ▶ Use the Flash Photo Gallery as a pagelet. This provides a quick and easy method to rotate images at specified intervals on a page.
