Site Availability: Dynamic Only.

The Gallery Main, Gallery Search and Gallery Item page types provide the functionality for an organization to create a gallery of select digital assets and enter details such as the artist, medium, size and location of the art piece.

The Gallery Main page provides visitors to your site with an introduction to a gallery. Enter introduction information about the gallery which will display above a single image from the gallery. This image will rotate at random displaying a different gallery image each time the page is loaded. This page is the parent page of the Gallery Search page.

Examples of when to use

- ▶ Create a virtual gallery of paintings, sculpture and mixed media.
- ▶ Create a virtual archival display of items that make up the history of your organization.
- ▶ Create a photo gallery of organization, community or educational events.

Gallery Main Page Sections & Fields

- ▶ Create the Main page as the parent page of the Gallery Search page.
- ▶ Use the provided editor window to enter text and a link to the search page that will display above a single gallery image.
- ▶ The image displayed on this page provides a link to the gallery item page.
- ▶ Provide text and graphics that will draw attention to the gallery and provide general information about the images a visitor to your site is about to view.
